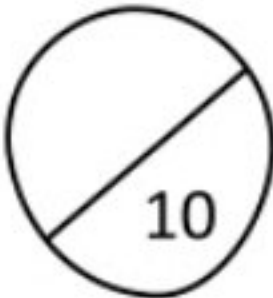

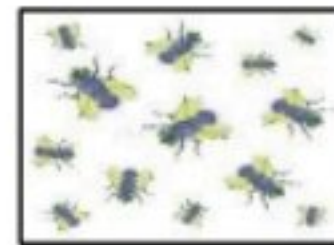

A Unique Hotel

There is a unique hotel that is located in Ottensheim, Austria, on the banks of the Danube River. It is called the Dasparkhotel. This hotel was created for travelers on a low budget.
